

UNSGAB Ministerial Dialogue

Main Points

- strengthened regional structures are needed post-2015 to support implementation of the SDGs
- greater coordination of the sector at the national level is essential, there continues to be too much fragmentation
- It is important countries have the flexibility to adapt the SDGs to their own needs – the MDGs were often overly prescriptive
- More strategic financing is crucial for the next development agenda
- “thinking bigger” for sanitation going forward, to incorporate systems including wastewater treatment
- A funded mechanism that facilitates Africa to Africa learning and capacity building is needed
- Harmonized monitoring is the only way to approach SDG 6
